

## Does your rear door rattle? Installing a “updated dovetail”

I found this on discoweb.org. If your rear door on a Discovery 1 is rattling, Land Rover offers updated parts to fit it.

The new dovetail has a roller to help with door alignment and a rubber pad to help with rattling.



Old style female dovetail

Old style male dovetail

Step 1-Remove old female dovetail.

Step 2-Screw new female dovetail, new dovetail uses two new longer screws, not the four old ones.

Step 3-Remove old male dovetail.

Step 4-Screw new male dovetail on with two of the old screws

Step 5-Do not completely tighten the screws on the female dovetail.

Step 6-Close the door to set the interlock depth.

Step 7-Reopen the door and tighten the screws on female dovetail.

Step 8-If door still rattles, loosen female dovetail and move to increase the interlock depth and re-tighten screws.
